TRYOUT EDITION

May is here and that brings us to the end of the season, tournaments and tryouts. On page 2 of this newsletter you will find a summary of the tryout information for this year. Your child is encouraged to try-out and play for teams that are compatible with their desires, temperament, personality, residence, experience, ability and provides them as much playing time as is reasonable practicable. Remember that you are committing to play on the team you register with for the entire year and that the Duke City League fee is non-refundable.

If this is your first tryout, your child should be dressed in shorts, shin guards and soccer cleats. They should bring a ball and water to drink during breaks. All of the tryouts have a time prior to the actual tryout to record personal data. There may be long lines so come early.

Rules for Tryouts

No player may be contacted by anyone other than his or her own team until May 21, 2007. They can not practice with another team prior to tryouts without the permission of their current coach.

Players may be offered a spot on a team after May 21 at 6:00 pm. However, nothing is binding until the official registration forms are filled out and turned into the Duke City office. These forms will be available on June 11 from the club registrars.

No teams are allowed to practice during the times tryouts are being held for their age groups.

Players should be able to attend all tryouts prior to having to make a decision. They should not be discouraged or intimidated from attending any or all of the tryouts.

Rules for Transferring

Transfers within clubs (from one club team to another team in the same club) are allowed throughout the year.

Transfers between different clubs are only allowed between December 15 and January 15.

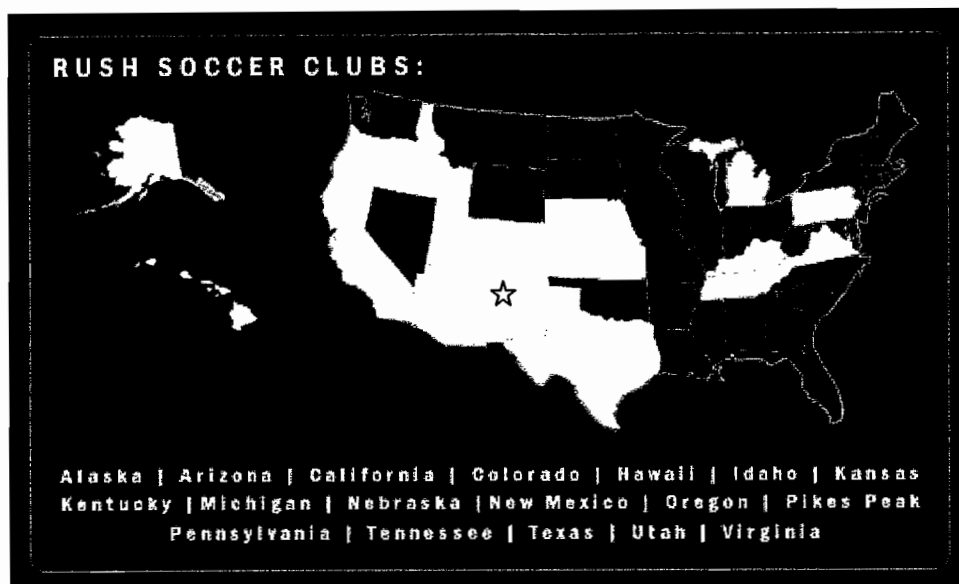

NEW MEXICO RUSH ACADEMY BRANCH COMPETITIVE U7 - U19 (Duke City Soccer League Teams)

Our Competitive Branch exists to allow any competitive player the opportunity to take their game to its full potential. Players play with other players of comparable with various levels of commitment throughout. The higher the level...the greater the commitment. Rush believes in striving for excellence. As players progress, they are constantly put in new situations to provide a greater challenge if that is what the player desires. For our top players, goals should include playing on the top Rush team in their specific age group, ODP state teams, regional teams, national teams, and college teams. For our club, we want to push our players to "the next level". This "next level" may be different for every player within NM Rush.

Player placement levels within New Mexico Rush Soccer Club

New Mexico Rush competitive players find placement in either the Rush's **Academy (Competitive U7-U19)** or **Youth Academy (Recreational U5-U6 and Developmental U7-U10)** divisions. Player movement within divisions is not uncommon. Academy teams represent the top players in the club as evaluated by the coaching staff. Within each age and gender the Rush has an overall goal consisting of three Academy teams, a top-level "Nike" team, a second-level "Swoosh" team, and a third level "Advanced" team. All of these Academy teams participate in an intensive program designed to develop skills to the highest possible level. Academy players can expect a year-round training schedule that can include out-of-state tournament travel, competition in the DCSL's Premier and Challenge brackets, advancement to state, regional and national championships, participation in the USYSA Olympic Development Program, and playing opportunities with nationwide interclub Rush select teams in various tournaments and US Club Soccer events. Academy teams, regardless of level, will receive top-level training from Rush staff coaches dedicated to developing the skills of these players throughout the calendar year.

- Top-level professional staff members, including former college players, former professional players, and nationally licensed coaches.

 - ♦ **College Prep Program:** The College Prep Program is designed for our U15 - U17 players. The College Prep Program is open to players ages U15-U17 and is designed to give these players extra training in during the spring season supplementary to their regular team training. These sessions are by invitation only and are run by age groups format. These sessions are run by NM Rush Directors of Coaching.
 - ♦ **2 UNM / Rush Weekend Soccer Camps:** This program is designed by UNM Men's soccer and NM Rush coaching staff. These camps are held every preseason (August and February) at the UNM south athletics complex. These programs are open to all registered Rush players.
 - ♦ **Rush Tutor Program:** The Tutor program simply means anyone in Rush has the opportunity to train with any team in Rush. Rush encourages players to play at a higher level within their age group or at an older age group. Players must check the team hotline number to find out the status of future training dates, times and locations.
 - ♦ **National Rush Discounts:** Discounted club pricing on Nike uniforms, apparel, and fans gear. Discounted club pricing on hotel travel through Choice Hotels International.

NEW MEXICO RUSH YOUTH ACADEMY BRANCH Westside and Eastside Soccer Programs

For Recreational U5-U13 and Developmental U7-U10 (Boys and Girls)

At the youngest ages, the game of soccer should be modified to suit the needs of the players. Players should be given as many touches on the ball as possible in both practice and game situations. A small-sided game such as 1v1 thru 8v8 for the appropriate age groups allows this to happen. New Mexico Rush has designed the following youth soccer programs for all beginning youth soccer players in the Albuquerque area. Whether your player lives on the Eastside or Westside of town NM Rush has the right program for your player!

U5 and U6 Bantam Program (Westside Program)

Cost: \$95 per year and includes the following;

- NWRGSL League Fee
- 1 UNM / NM Rush Weekend Soccer Camp
- Monthly coaching education for volunteer team coaches
- Additional costs: \$30 uniform fee which includes; 2 t-shirts, 1 short, and 1 pair of socks (uniform includes numbers and club logo)

- 3)** U7 and U8 Developmental players should attend the NM Rush Tryouts on May 29, 2007 at Balloon Fiesta Park from 5-8pm.

The NM Rush East Side Youth Academy is designed to introduce players to the game of soccer in a fun-filled and safe environment. Under the guidance of our NM Rush Professional Staff, players and coaches are introduced to "The Rush Way", a philosophy of coaching based on USYSA standards and research. Volunteer coaches will be taught the proper coaching techniques to use with children of this age, so as to ensure that kids develop a love for the game. After this program, kids are ready to play on their own team in our Developmental Program starting at U7.

U7 and up Recreational Program (Westside Program)

All RVFC Goalkeepers have the option to attend one professionally coached goalkeeper session each week for the duration of the season. Players U14 and below will have the option to attend nine one-hour sessions in the fall and a further nine in the spring. Players U15 and above will receive nine one-hour sessions in the spring. The commencement date for these sessions and the time slot allotted to each team will be determined by the Director of Goalkeeper Coaching and announced at the coaches meeting prior to each season. Players are required to attend punctually and bring their own ball to each session. The skill sessions will follow a curriculum laid down by the RVFC. This curriculum will be age specific and will focus on the technical and tactical aspects of the game. To this end RVFC will employ a full time Goalkeeping Director and goalkeeping staff where necessary. The Goalkeeping Director will offer additional sessions as he sees fit outside of each coaching season. The Goalkeeping Director will also offer goalkeeping camps and one-on-one sessions to interested parties.
