TRYOUT EDITION

Well that time of year is here again, TRYOUTS. It is a time when coaches, parents, players, and club officials look forward to or are completely stressed out with. Your child is encouraged to try-out and play for teams that are compatible with their desires, temperament, personality, experience, and ability. On page 2 of this newsletter you will find a summary of the tryout information for each age group and clubs for this year.

Things You Should Do and Ask at a Tryout

If this is your first tryout, your child should be dressed in shorts, shin guards and soccer cleats. You should bring a ball and water to drink during breaks. All of the tryouts have a time prior to the actual tryout to record personal data. There may be long lines so come early.

Ask the following questions: What is the cost? Ask for a cost breakdown sheet. When are practices? How long are practices? How many tournaments will the team be in? Are tournaments included in the cost? Are all practices, skill sessions, scrimmages, and tournaments mandatory? What is the team goal? What is the club philosophy and plan for teams and individual players? What kind of player is the team and/or club looking for? What is the coaches' plan for playing time? Will the Club or Coach move a more advanced player to a more competitive team during the season? Is the team your son or daughter trying out for a Premier, Challenge, or Recreational team? Etc.

Rules for Tryouts

No player may be contacted by anyone other than his or her own team until 6 P.M. May 18, 2009. They cannot practice and tryout with another team prior to the DCSL scheduled tryouts without the permission of their current coach.

Recruitment or attempting to induce a registered player of any team under the jurisdiction of NMYSA by contacting the player, either through its responsible officials, officers, coaches, parents, players or representatives, prior to the conclusion of the US Youth Soccer New Mexico Open State Cup Tournament for the purpose of playing for another team is considered POACHING.

Players may be offered a spot on a team after May 18 at 6:00 pm. However, nothing is binding until the official registration forms are filled out and turned into the Duke City office. These forms will be available on June 8 from the club registrars.

No teams are allowed to practice during the times tryouts are being held for their age groups.

Players should be able to attend all tryouts prior to having to make a decision. They should not be discouraged or intimidated from attending any or all of the tryouts.

Rules for Transferring

Transfers within clubs (from one club team to another team in the same club) are allowed throughout the year.

Transfers between clubs and leagues are only allowed between December 15 and January 15.

Remember that you are committing to play on the team you register with for the entire year and that the Duke City League fee is non-refundable.

If you have any question or concerns do not hesitate to call us. Good luck, have a great summer, and see you next year on the pitch.

PROVISIONAL ACCEPTANCE FOR AGES UNDER U-8. The Director may accept a team younger than U-8 to play as a U-8 team if in the judgment of the Director the team is capable of competing against older players.

DIVISIONS: Teams will be grouped into divisions based upon age, gender and ability level, so as to achieve competitive balance. Teams will be divided into premier, competitive or recreational divisions for girls and boys. The number of divisions within an age group will be determined by the number of teams.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS: The Team Registration Fee and the Team Referee Fee are fully refundable, and a team's registration may be canceled if written notification from the Team Contact Person is received by the registrar on or before May 18, 2009. ALBUQUERQUE UNITED FC U5/U6 YOUNG DRAGONS ACADEMY

Players eligible to play in the U5/U6 Young Dragons Academy will take part in a 16 week training program. The program is broken into two 8 week seasons, one in the fall and one in the spring. In these 8 week seasons there will be 5 opportunities per week for fun and engaging soccer activity provided by our professional coaching staff. Players and families are given the ability to choose which training days, times and locations will work best for them. Those players and families can attend as many as 5 playing opportunities a week or as few as one opportunity a week. Training sessions will be held weekdays (Monday thru Thursday) after school, and matches will be on Saturdays.

On match day the players will play 4v4 or 3v3 matches without goalkeepers. They play with and against one another in our own AUFC U5/U6 league. The 4v4 and 3v3 small sided format is put into place so that these young players will maximize the amount of touches on the ball they can take in a match. For these young players the number of touches on a ball that they can take in a short time is essential to help develop their individual technical abilities. These players need to work on balance, coordination and getting a feel for having a round ball at their feet. Also, 4 players vs. 4 players or 3 players vs. 3 players are the ideal match conditions for allowing players of this age to be exposed to the essential small group tactical elements of the game of soccer. Although players of this age will not be mentally capable of understanding tactics within the game, we still attempt to expose them to that environment so that they gain the experience even without understanding it.

The only time that teams will be put together is on match day, and players will constantly be put onto different teams with one another even within the same match day. No scores are kept, and our field set up on match day allows for 3-4 matches to be played at the same time. Our coaches may move players around from match to match. This style of operating youth matches allows for players of certain levels to be identified and paired up with and against players of similar abilities. By doing this we also minimize players time spent off of the field so that they are playing the majority of the time they are present on match day.

Lastly, our professional coaching staff is comprised of individuals who are educated and experienced in working with youth within the sport of soccer and in other areas of youth education. It is important to AUFC that our coaches not only understand the game of soccer but also understand the players that they are working with. By having a coaching staff that understands the mental and physical capabilities of 4, 5 and 6 year olds we can design training sessions and match conditions that favor success and development for our young aspiring soccer players.

ALBUQUERQUE UNITED FC U7/U8 DEVELOPMENTAL PROGRAM

Players eligible to play in the AUFC U7/U8 developmental program will take part in a 20 week training program. The program is broken into two 10 week seasons, one in the fall and one in the spring. In these 10 week seasons there will be 3 opportunities per week for soccer activity provided by our AUFC professional coaching staff. Training sessions will be held weekdays after school, and matches will be on Saturdays.

The U7/U8 developmental program is intended to create an environment for young players to experience the game of soccer in a fun atmosphere with knowledgeable coaches. The U7 and U8 years for these players are very important to help them develop good individual skills and habits within the sport of soccer so that they can have success as they enter their older and more competitive years within the sport.

On match day the players will play 4 players vs. 4 players. They play on set teams in the Duke City Soccer League. Each team roster can hold a maximum of 8 players. The 4 vs. 4 format is put into place so that these young players will maximize the amount of individual touches on the ball they can take in a match. The individual technical abilities of our U7 and U8 players is the focus of this program and thus the 4 vs. 4 format fits well into the programs developmental goals. 4 players vs. 4 players is also the ideal format for players to begin to understand all the essential small group tactical elements of the game of soccer. Although players of this age may not be mentally capable yet of understanding small group tactics in soccer the environment must still be created for their long term development.

Each year coaches are chosen from or added to our AUFC coaching staff to head coach our U7 and U8 teams on both the boys and the girl's side. These coaches will decide when and where the team(s) will train. Our newer and older coaches are chosen for these ages because they are educated and experienced in developing "age appropriate" training sessions for our U7 and U8 players. There are no tryouts for the U7 and U8 teams. We have a set amount of spots available for interested players. Teams are formed from interested players contacting AUFC and once all the spots are full then we begin a waiting list for any interested players.

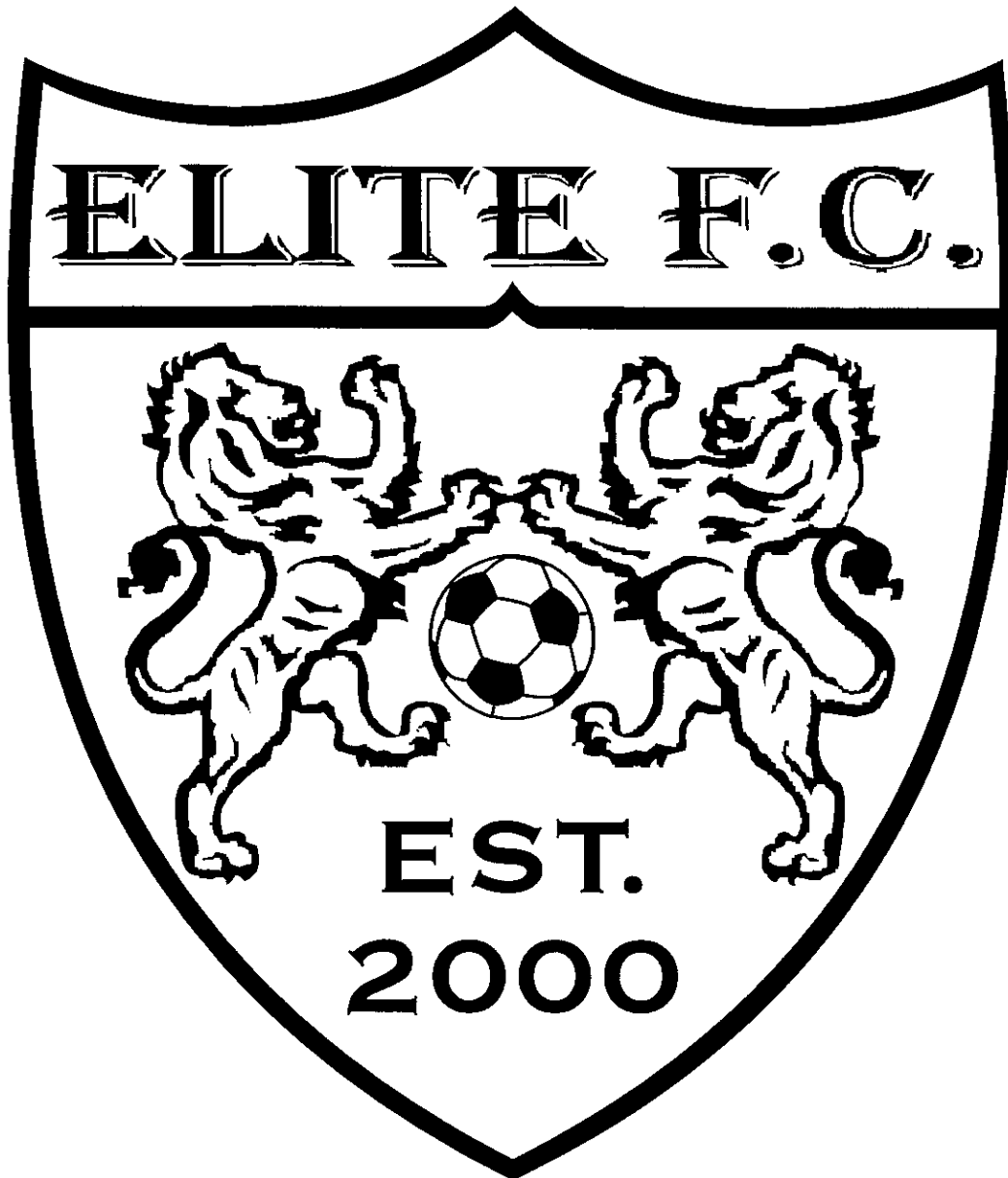

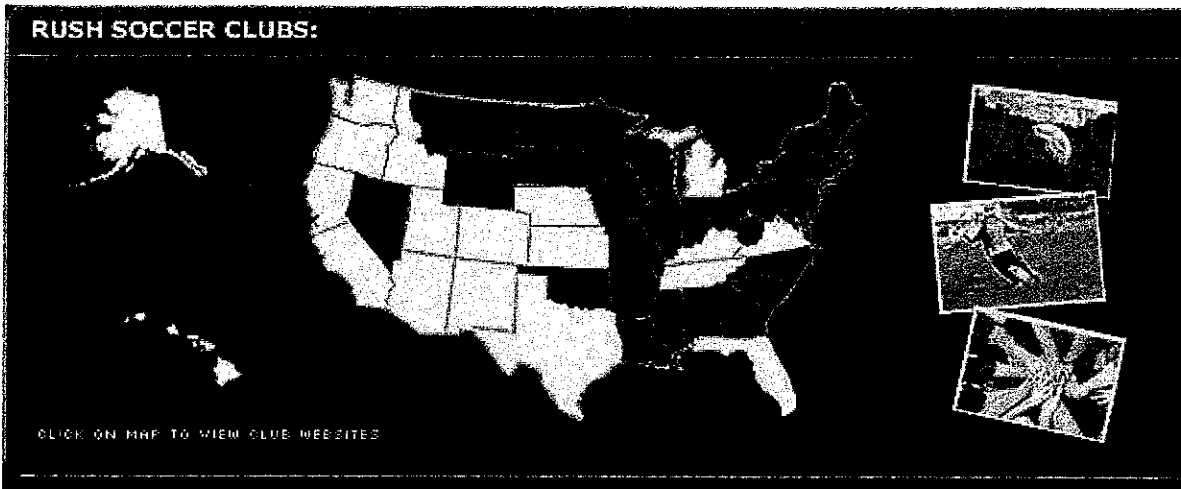
